Financial Assistance for Membership and Programs

Financial Assistance for Membership and Programs is available to individuals and families with annual household income under \$65,000.

Using our Income-Based Rate Scale, your monthly membership rate or program fee may be reduced 10%-40% based on your annual household income.

We understand your financial records may not reflect the entire picture of your financial needs. With this in mind, we provide additional assistance based on need. You will be asked to provide the following documents:

- Copy of the most recent 1040 Tax Return for all adults (above age of 25) in the household.
 If you do not file taxes, you may obtain an IRS transcript by calling the Internal Revenue
 Service at 1.800.829.1040 or go to irs.gov.
- Social Security Award Letter(s) or Disability Letter(s), in lieu of Tax Return.
